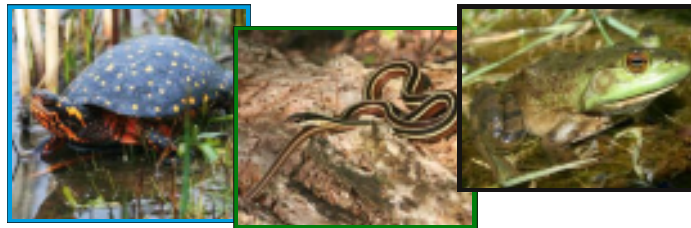


An evening with
